Item 2: Charlottetown Tennis Club photograph: [Ca. 1911]. - Copied 1977. - 1 photograph

On May 14, 1889, eleven men met and decided to form a tennis club, namely, the Charlottetown Lawn Tennis Club. It was however, not the first of its kind in the city. The MicMac Lawn Tennis Club and the Fitzroy Tennis Club were already in existence and were invited to join the Charlottetown club. The Fitzroy group consented to join on the condition that the constitution be amended so as to admit ladies into full membership, rather than the associate membership which did not permit them any voice in the club's business. In 1907, the club joined the Maritime Lawn Tennis League and retained its membership in that organization until 1930 when the Prince Edward Island Lawn Tennis Association was formed and became affiliated with the Canadian Lawn Tennis Association.
