Church records were transcribed under the direction of Eileen Oulton from five Catholic churches in West Prince during the early 1970s.

Sub-Series 5: Cemetery Records

West Prince Cemetery transcripts compiled under the direction of Eileen Oulton during the summers of 1973 and 1975.

Inventory lists were compiled in alphabetical order on family names from A-Z which were gathered from the tombstone transcriptions in the mid-1970s.
